The stated reason for the visit was to inquire about the unereabouts and collect and additional information about According to our reports Mr. McNichols answered the questions asked by the agents and the agents left the premises.

The alarming factor of the occurence, is the fact that this same mission was broken into several days later on the night of the 20-21 of October. Several items where found missing form the mission.

Due to the recent press accounts concerning F3I break-ins, it would ease our minds considerably to have you look into this matter and verify the extent of the FBI involvement in this break-in. Hopefully you will discover that this was not an FBI ploy as I beleive that our Church has been most accomadating to the Bureau in its investigation.

By letter dated September 7, 1951, the officer in charge of the 115th CIC Detachment, Intelligence Field Office #3, 208 James Street, Seattle, Washington, requested to be informed if the Federal Bureau of Investigation had conducted, or contemplated conducting an investigation of the Dianetic Clinic, Seattle, because of information received that the Clinic was presided over by a Communist Party member and further infiltraded by other Communist Party members. In written response, September 14, 1951, it was indicated that a preliminary inquiry was being made to determine if sufficient basis to conduct a full scale investigation existed. It was noted that all pertinent information in Seattle FBI files had recently been furnished to a representative of that office. On October 6, 1951, it was recommended that no investigation of the Dianetic Clinic, Seattle, be conducted since it appeared there was insufficient infiltration into the organization by members of the Communist Party to merit such investigation. On November 3, 1966,

Scientology Raid Yielded Alleged Burglary Topls

FBI agents who searched the Los Angeles headquarters of the Church of Scientology last Friday recovered electronic eavesdropping equipment and items described by the agents as "burglary tools" from a safe there, aceording to several sources familiar with the search.

The items were among those listed in a 459-page inventory of the search prepared by the FBI, the sources said. The agents reportedly confiscated as many, as 200,000 documents in the gearch, so many that it took a truck to haul the materials away.

A church spokesman in Los Angeles, the Rev. Vaughan Young, said he could not comment on the alleged results of the search on the advice of the church's attorneys. Instead, he released a, statement similar to others issued by church spokesmen since the raid, queitioning the FBI's motives in the search, and saying it was an illegal seizure of church property.

Also found in the Los Angeles search were copies of documents reportedly stolen from federal offices in Washington, according to the inventory.

Agents raided the church's headquarters in Los Angeles and offices in Washington largely on the basis of information from a former church official, who claimed the church's hierarchy had masterminded a plot to infiltrate government agencies, steal and copy government files, and bug government meetings.

The former official, Michael Meisner, reportedly told agents before the search that he was personally aware of incidents in which the church allegedly bugged government meetings.

One such alleged bugging occurred in the Internal Revenue Service headquarters here on Nov. 1, 1974, according to Meisner's account.

On that date, Meisner told federal officials, two scientologists "surreptitiously entered the IRS building and placed a listening device in a conference room, which they knew was about to be used for a high

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level IRS meeting on the Church of Scientology."

The meeting, which IRS files show then took place as scheduled, included representatives from various sections of the IRS who were interested in the church's financial activities.

Meisner said one of the scientologists who allegedly bugged the meeting later told him what had occurred there, and that he had also seen at the Los Angeles headquarters of the church a transcript of the secretly produced tape of the session.

There was no indication that such a transcript was recovered in the Los Angeles search.

Meisner, who has been placed in protective custoy of U. S. marshals, told agents he had been held under "house arrest" by the scientologists when they believed he was going to go to the federal government with his information about the church.


Meisner reportedly asked for the protection because of what has been described as the church's flair game" doctrine, which reportedly requires the church to attack and destroy its enemies, "suppressive persons," and persons who leave the church.

The bugging incident involving the IRS was only one of allegedly numerous successful attempts in which covert agents for the church stole government files and infiltrated agencies, according to court records. Other agencies allegedly targeted by the church included the Justice Department, the U.S. Attorney's Office here, and the Drug Enforcement Administration, the court records indicate.

In his statement yesterday, church spokesman Young characterized the raid as "part of a consistent campaign of harassment" against the church by federal government agencies. The federal government began

The federal government began amassing materials on the church soon after it was founded in the early 1950s, and has been involved in lengthy litigation on various aspects of the church's activities. It has questioned the church's claims concerning lie-detector-like "E-meters" used in the church's religious counseling, and also the church's tax-exempt status as a religion.

The investigation is progressing and there is resently pending in United States District Courts litigation Envolving the documents seized by the FBI on July 8 and July 9, 1977. Until this litigation is terminated and all documents reviewed, we are unable to comply with your request.

The FBI will cooperate fully with the Defense Communications Agency (DCA) in line with instructions issued by the appropriate United States Attorneys and the orders from the United States District Courts. This investigation is receiving preferred investigative and supervisory attention and your agency will be kept advised of all facets which pertain to DCA files and/or documents which have been or may have been accesses or copied by FCS pprsonnel.

Attorney's Office or of the Department of Justice or any Governmental agency involved in civil litigation against the moving party or any of its affiliated groups. 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

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
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
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### CRIMINAL INVEST ATIVE DIVISION July 28, 1977

Attached teletype pertains to the Federal criminal investigation of members and former members of the Church of Scientology (COS). Attorneys for the COS filed a motion in U. S. District Court, Washington, D. C., for the return of property seized from the COS in Washington, D. C., during the execution of a search warrant on 7/8/77. The defendants claim under the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, that (1) the warrant was unconstitutionally general, (2) the search and seizure were unreasonable in scope, amounting to a general exploratory search, (3) the Agents executing the warrant violated Title 18, U.S.C., Section 3109, by using excessive force in the execution of the warrant. The U. S. Attorney's Office filed a motion in opposition to supra motion.

On 7/27/77, in U. S. District Court, a hearing was held before Chief Judge William B. Bryant concerning the validity of the search warrant. Judge Bryant ruled the search warrant to be too broad to support conspiracy charges and ordered the documents seized to be turned over to the court.

U. S. Attorney Earl J. Silbert conferred with Deputy Assistant Attorney General John C. Keeney, Criminal Division, and it was decided the Government would appeal if at all possible. Mr. Keeney advised FBIHQ the appeal would be handled by the Appellate Section of the Criminal Division on an expeditious basis.

# Scientology Raid Unconstitutional, U:S. Judge Rules

By J. Y. Smith Washington Post Staff Writer. A U.S. judge ruled yesterday that the government must return documents seized in an FBI raid on the Foundation Church of Scientelogy here July 8 because the search warrant used was unconstitutionally broad.

The raid on the church offices at 2125 S St. NW and a similar operation against Scientology offices in Los Angeles were made in connection with an investigation of alleged conspiracies by church officials. The purpose of the alleged conspiracies was to burglarize government offices, steal government property, and abstruct criminal investigations. according to court documents.

Chief Judge William B. Bryant of U.S. District Court ordered that all the materials seized here, and all copies and records of such materials. be impounded by the clerk of the court He said the material would be returned to church of/icials unless the government appeals his ruling within 10 days.

The ruling applies only to the Washington raid. The Los Angeles raid is the subject of another court proceeding there.

A spokesman for the U.S. Attorney's Office, which has been directing the investigation against the church here, said the office had recommended to the Justice Department that an appeal be taken.

# **Court Supports Job Rights** Of Women Rejecting Boss

#### By J. Y. Smith Washington Post Biaff Writer

Women denicd employment or promotion because they refuse to give sexual favors to superiors can seek recress under federal civil rights legislation, the U.S. Court of Appeals ruled yesterday.

In what appears to be the first federal appeals court ruling on the question, the court said women subjected to requests for sex from their bosses are protected by Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1972.

"We cannot doubt that Title VII intercepts the discriminatory practice charged here," wrote Circuit Judge Spottswood W. Robinson III Ju. m opinion in which Chief Judge David L. Bazelon concurred and in which Circuit Judge George E. MacKinnon concurred in a separate option.

The judges noted that various U.S.

District Courts had reached different results in similar cases.

The case the appeals court here decided was a suit brought by Paulette L. Barnes, a black woman. She said she had been hired by the Environmental Protection Agency as a GS-5 administrative assistant. She said that at her hiring interview she was promised promotion to grade GS-7 "within 90 days," according to the court record.

Shortly after she began work, the court said, her boss repeatedly suggested that "if she cooperated with him in a sexual affair, her employment status would be enhanced," according to her complaint.

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When she persisted in her refusals, he said, her job was abolished and she was reasigned elsewhere in the agency as a GS-5, Her former job was elevated to grade GS-12 and given to a white woman, the court said.

. After numerous administrative hearings in which she asserted that she had been the victim of racial, rather than sexual, discrimination, she filled suit in U.S. District Court here.

The District Court held that her boss's alleged relaliatory action on her refusal to engage in an "afterhour affair" was "not the type of disciminatory act comtemplated by" the federal civil rights law.

In reversing that ruling, the appeals court said: "But for her womanhood. from aucht that appears, her participation in sexual activity would never have been solicited.

"To say, then, that she was vicfinized in her employment simply because she declined the invitation is to ignore the asserted fact that she was invited only because she was a woman subordinate to the inviter in the hierarchy of agency personnel."

The court directed that the case he returned to the District Court so that Barnes would have a chance to prove her claim of sexual discrimination.

The warrant used in Washington listed 148 specific items that were rought, In addition, it sought other material and its final paragraph authorized agents to seize "any and all fruits, instrumentalities and evidence (at this time unknown) of the crimus of conspiracy, obstruction of justice and theft of government property ... " Judge Biyant ruled that this language was so broad that it amounted to a "general warrant"-authority to seize anything and everything at the discretion of the agents-and that it therefore violated the guarantee of the Fourth Amendment of the U.S. Constitution against "unreasonable searches and seizures."

The Constitution requires that search warrants list the items sought with "particularity," Bryant said, "General warrants" lack this particularity.

"The flaw I find in the warrant inwolved here is precisely the evil that inheres in general warrants," Bryant wrote. 


CID approves the expenditure of \$50,000.00, in the Sitol case, to reproduce 6 xerox copies of approximately 20,000 documents by the Los Angeles Division. It is contemplated Los Angeles will utilize approximately 10 xerox machines obtained from the Xerox Reproduction Center in Los Angeles. SAC - Criminal, Los Angeles, advises Xerox Corporation will furnish one operator to assist the crew of Agents at each machine to reproduce the documents. The SAC, further stated that these Xerox employees are cleared for top secret and will function in a support role to maintain the xerox machines during the reproducing operation. The documents will remain in the custody of FBI Agents during the xeroxing process. Assistant United States Attorneys from Washington, D. C., in Los Angeles, have advised the SAC that it will be necessary to xerox the 20,000 documents obtained in the Sitol case so they can be reviewed without contaminating the evidence. Those documents which are not pertinent will probably be returned to the Founding Church of Scientology. 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

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AGENTS DID NOT BREAK DOWN ANY DOORS WHEN SCIENTOLOGISTS OFFERED KEYS. IN FACT, AS STATED ABOVE, DOORS AT CEDARS-SINAI NOT BROKEN UNTIL EIGHT A.M., AFTER TWO HOUR WAIT.

IT IS A FACT THAT DOORS WERE BROKEN BY SLEDGE HAMMERS, CROWBARS AND SAWS. POWER DRILLS WERE UT IL IZED TO OPEN CABINETS, AND LOCK CUTTERS WERE USED TO CUT BOLTS, ALL OF WHICH FORCE WAS NECESSARY AND WELL WITHIN THE POWERS GRANTED IN THE SEARCH WARRANT.

THE CHURCH SAID AN ESTIMATED 100,000 PAGES OF DOCUMENTS WERE SEIZED BY THE AGENTS, ALTHOUGH ONLY 156 DOCUMENTS WERE SPECIFIED BY THE WARRANT. SOME OF THE FILES SEIZED WERE "PRIVILEGED ATTOR NEY-CLIENT DOCUMENTS CONTAINING LEGAL STRATEGY IN ONCOMING SUITS THE CHURCH HAS AGAINST THE PAGE EIGHT (47-12230) E F T O GOVERNMENT AND THE PLANNING FOR POSSIBLE FUTURE SUITS."

ALL AGENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE SEARCH WERE BRIEFED ABOUT THE FACTS IN THE AFFIDAVIT TO THE SEARCH WARRANT AND WERE ALSO BRIEFED FOR SEVERAL HOURS BY FBI OFFICIALS AND THE TWO ASSISTANT UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS FROM WASHINGTON, D. C. DURING THE SEARCH, THESE TWO ATTORNEYS, AS WELL AS LEGAL INSTRUCTORS FROM THE LOS ANGELES OFFICE, ROAMED THROUGHOUT THE SEARCH AREA AND ANSWERED QUESTED NS REGARDING PROPRIETY OF SEIZING DOCUMENTS. NO ATTORNEY-CLIENT DOCUMENTS ARE KNOWN TO HAVE BEEN SEIZED.

PURPOSE: To advise regarding unfounded allegations contained In the "Atlanta Constitution" and "The Los Angeles Times" newspapers on 7/19/77 alleging misconduct by Special Agent (SAS) during the search of the Church of Scientology properties in Los Angeles, California, and Washington, D. C. on 7/8-9/77.

SYNOPSIS: The 7/19/77 issues of "The Los Angeles Times" and "Atlanta Constitution" newspapers contained unfounded allegations of misconduct by Special Agents of the FBI in conducting authorized searches of the properties of the Church of Scientology in the Los Angeles, California, area and Washington, D. C., on 7/8-9/77. Search warrants for the two Los Angeles properties were not restrictive to certain areas and covered "The Los Angeles Times" article stated, the entire buildings. "A Church spokesman called the FBIs' actions 'gestapo like.'" An alleged Special Agent burst into rooms where married couples were sleeping unclothed and burst into shower stalls where people were bathing." SAC-Criminal, Los Angeles, received no reports by search teams that Agents went into rooms occupied by unclothed occupants and burst into shower stalls where people were bathing.

were bathing. "The Los Angeles Times" article further indicated "One female Church member trying to take a picture of an FBI Agent was struck on the head with a clipboard by the Agent." SAC-Criminal, Los Angeles, advised no Agent struck anyone over the head with a clipboard. SA thrust into his face by a female Scientologist and SA moved a clipboard to shield his eyes from the flashbulb and accidently struck the camera shick was within a Toot of SAC face. All with a clipboard to come a shick was within a toot of SAC

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

Throughout the entire search in the Los Angeles area, numerous Scientologists followed Agents, taking hundreds of photographs with flashbulbs in close proximity to the Agents' eyes. SAC-Criminal warned numerous Scientologists throughout the day that they were bordering on interfering with a lawful search and instructed them to leave the area.

In addition, SAC-Criminal advised that every opportunity was given to the Scientologists to produce keys; however, after a reasonable period, it became necessary to forcibly enter some desks and some rooms. At the two locations, Los Angeles Special Agents used utmost restraint and discretion throughout the long search which lasted about 21 hours. Special Agents were subject to various types of harassing activities and verbal abuse.

The "Atlanta Constitution" contained a similar article to "The Los Angeles Times"; however, in addition, states "In the suit, Church officials quoted one of the FBI Agents who allegedly took part in the raids in Los Angeles as saying the sweep was 'The most brutal search and seizure I've ever seen or been involved in.'" SAC-Criminal advised there is no indication any Agent made such a statement. It is obvious that from the above-mentioned newspaper articles that the organization's allegations are in line with known and established tactics of the Church of Scientology when dealing with law enforcement agencies who come in conflict with the Church during the performance of their law enforcement functions.

In reply to the requests of Los Angeles that FBIHQ contact the Department in an effort to accelerate court action pending in Los Angeles; on 7/22/77, SA John C. Gordon, General Government Crimes Unit, contacted Deputy Assistant Attorney General, John C. Keeney, Criminal Division. Mr. Keeney advised all matters pertaining to the prosecution of this case are to be routinely brought to the attention of U. S. Attorney Earl Silbert, Washington, D. C.

# Scientology Church Suing FBI on Raids

LOS ANGELES (UPI) - The Church of Scientology, whose offices were raided by federal agents last werk in Los Angeles and Washington, filed a \$7.9 million damage suit in federal court Monday, accusing the FBI of using "Gestapo-like" tactics in the raids.

The church named as defendants two deputy U.S. attorneys and 134 FBI agents who conducted the simultaneous early morning raids in the two cities July 8.

Documents taken in the raids - some of which were believed related to alleged infiltration by church members into various government departments - were ordered

temporarily sealed at the request of the church by federal judges in both cities.

In the suit, church officials quoted one of the FBI agents who allegedly took part in the raids in Los Angeles as saying the sweep was "the most brutal search and seizure I've ever seen or been involved in."

The suit said the raids resulted in extensive "unnecessary" physical damage to the church buildings and were "unlawful, unconstitutional ... intrusions into the privacy of its parisbioners."

The church said that even when members repeatedly offered to supply keys and to open doors for the agents, they went ahead with sledge hammers, battering rams, power suws, power drills and crowbars to force their way in

About 30 agents who raided the Los Angeles headquarters shouled, "FBI, me have a search warrant," but went directly to a floor not covered by the warrant, the suit alleged. It sold they burst into rooms where "married couples were sleeping unclothed and deliterately invaced their privacy."

The church said an estimated 100,000 pages of documents were seized by the agents although only 156 documents were specified by the warrant, the suit said.

Some of the files seized were "priviledged attorney-client documents containing legal strategy in oncoming suits the church has against the government and the planning for possible future suits."

Church officials charged that the raids were part of a "campaign of harassment and retaliation" for the Scientologists' "exposures of government abuse."

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

The Church of Scientology Monday filed a \$7.8 million damage suit against two Justice Department attorneys and 134 unnamed FBI agents . who the church said scized thousands of documents in raids July 8 on two Los Angeles church locations.

The raids were motivated, the church alleged, by the government's desire to retaliate against Scientologists because of the many lawsuits the church has filed against governmental agencies.

Estimates of how many documents were seized have ranged from 20,000 to 100,000. The church claimed the papers were seized so they be used by the government to defend itself against the Scientologists' lawsuits.

raids in Los Angeles and a third one at the church's headquarters in Washington, D.C., were based on allegations by a former high church official that the hierarchy of the church was involved in extensive criminal activities.

The former official, Michael Meisner, has admitted taking part in three burglaries in the U.S. Courthouse in Washington and has attempted to implicate other church officials in the break-ins.

The alleged purpose of the illegal entries was to obtain documents about the church which it had been unable to obtain through Freedom of Information Act lawsuits.

Scientology considers itself an applied religious philosophy which altempts to increase an individual's self-knowledge and self-awareness.

Attorncys for the church have charged that there was not probable cause to conduct the raids on the church locations and that agents using power saws, crowbars and battering rams did extensive damage to areas not specified in the warrant.

The actions of the FBI constituted a violation of the church First Amendment right to freedom of speech and religion as well as Fourth Amendenent.right against an illegal search and seizure, the suit said.

A church spokesman called the FBI's actions "Gestapo-like." The suit charged agents "chanting, 'FBI--we have a search warrant'. . . burst into rooms where married couples were sleeping unclothed . . . and burst into shower stalls where people were bathing."

One female church member trying to take a picture of an FBI agent was struck on the head with a clip-board by the agent, according to church spokesman Vaughn Young at a Greater Los Angeles Press Club news conference.

At the old Cedars-Sinai hospital complex, 4833 Fcontain Ave., now owned by the church, agents "roamed and searched at will" on the upper five floors of the building, the suit said. The search warrant specifically identified the first-floor office area as the focus for the search.

More than 150 specifically identified documents alleged-Search warrants authorizing the ly stolen or copied in the Washington burglaries were sought in the search of the church locations.

Young was particularly critical of the authority given by the search warrant for the FBI to take any documents or evidence about crimes of conspiracy, obstruction of justice or theft of government property.

It was under that authority that the FBI seized the vast majority of the documents in the search. In addition, lockpicking equipment, cavesdropping devices and dossiers on government officials also were taken by the FBI, it was lcarned.

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


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

LOSS OR COMPROMISE OF CLASSIFIED INFORMATIO

Reference is made to your memorandum dated July 18, 1977, relating to the possible loss or compromise of classified information as a result of penetration activities of members of the Founding Church of Scientology, and requesting that this Bureau's Security Officer provide a preliminary report prior to July 29, 1977, and a final report by September 1, 1977, which will enable the Department to make a damage assessment.

This Bureau has custody of voluminous documents obtained from the Founding Church of Scientology offices in Washington, D. C., and in the Los Angeles area as the result of execution of Federal search warrants on July 8 and 9, 1977. Investimation is continuing regarding alleged violations of Pederal statutes involving members and former members of the Church, and the documents seized are being subjected to systematic review. On July 19, 1977, this Bureau's Document Classification Officer (Security Officer) furnished the Department Review Committee a preliminary overview of this investigation and of the extensive review required of documents to determine possible loss or compromise of national security information. The Department Review Committee was advised this investigation is progressing and, consistent with matters relating to litigation in the U.S. District Courts, the Department and all other appropriate agencies would be alerted to all facets pertaining to their interests at the earliest possible date.

The FEI Document Classification Officer (Security Officer) has been in contact with Mr. D. Jerry Rubino of the Department Security Programs Staff regarding this matter, and you may be assured of our full cooperation.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT FROM THE CHURCH OF SCIENTOLOGY

In the early morning hours today, our Churches in Los Angeles and Washington D.C., were the target of a Gestapo, policestate raid as retaliation for recent attempts at government reform and an attempt to cover up a massive international narcotics operation known to officials of the US and some foreign governments. For the past three years the Church of Scientology has sponsored the National Commission on Law Enforcement and Social Justice's investigation of Interpol, the private French-based police association. Two years ago we first heard the rumors that there was another aspect to the infamous "French Connection" that involved both Interpol and governmental officials. But it was not until a few months ago when the NCLE's Director of Research toured Europe that we were able to uncover the first supporting evidence. Only weeks ago did we make this material public, requesting that the Lepartment of Justice investigate the evidence we found. The Justice Department's response came early this morning when FBI agents took sledgehammers, crowbars and look. cutters to our Churches and broke into our offices before the staff could even arrive which is an illegal act.

For us, this is not new. In 1963 the federal government perpetrated a similar raid on the Founding Church in Washington, D.C., carting off several tons of religious materials. We fought that battle for 10 years in the courts and finally won the case with the government returning all seized materials.

Since then we have employed the Freedom of Information Act

to force further disclosure of governmental harassment and false information circulated by federal officials and have found shocking false reports.

At every step the government has responded with a Nazi mentality and this latest tactic proves to us beyond a reasonable doubt that the government is terrified and is resorting to the final, frantic attempts to prevent the ultimate disclosures both we and they know lie behind their brutalities today.

Even their allegations of stolen governmental records is not new, either with us or with others. Daniel Effsberg's psychiatrist's office was broken into when he obtained the Pentagon Papers. The FBI has executed "Black Bag" jobs around the country. But now the tactic is more brutal and sledgehammers have replaced the quiet and covert entry.

A few months ago the NCLE's kesearch Director was traveling through Europe to find the drug and CIA connections we had heard rumored so long. The retaliation there was to attack him in the media as a fraud and swindler who was also peddling forged or stolen US governmental comments. The documents-turned out to be a report on Interpol published by the General Accounting Office and purchasable for one dollar.

That same trumped-up charge has now appeared with the FBI who are making the same false allegations in order to break into our offices and confiscate wholesale what they have not been able to find in mail covers and other means. The FBI has not permitted the Church to xerox copies of material they took, however Church observers indicate that FBI is on a fishing expedition. In fact they have taken Church documents and documents obtained by the Church under the Preedom of Information Act.

The history and tactics of the PBI are becoming painfully known to the American public and this latest Gestapo raid shows there has been no reform in government dirty tricks. They have, in effect, proven to us that our research is correct, that there is a massive, international narcotics cartel heretofore unrevealed which is operating with the knowledge and consent of highly placed governmental officials both here and abroad who will go to any means and use any tactics to prevent its disclosure.

That secret cartel is behind the heroin and cocaine smuggling into this country and extends into the highest ranks of the French Judicial and police systems. Thus it is no coincidence that our Church in France Was raided last year during that probe.

We are not talking about a few distonest cops. We are talking about an operation that is being run with the blessing of French officials and the cooperation of American officials in Washington from whence the orders for this raid came.

The raid of a church is in keeping with their criminal mentality and we are now rededicating ourselves to the fight not only for religious liberty but to expose those who are seeking to turn this country into a police state.

Our past history of vigorous government reform and the 750 million dollar suit against the US government for conspiracy filed by the Church of Scientology several months ago is certainly motive enough for the US government to use whatever reason they could create to get to our information and legal documents. We of course, are taking immediate legal action.



I am writing to you to express my deep concern about last week's FBI raid on the Church of Scientology in Washington, D.C. I am a Scientologist, and I hold my beliefs yery dearly. This letter is not about the validity of religious beliefs, nor is it an attempt to persuade you to mine.

The Church of Scientology has continually fought court battles against government super-agencies, most notably the IRS and the FDA. These court cases have also continuously been won by the Church of Scientology. Most recently the Church has sued the FBI for documents suspected of being withheld contrary to the Freedom of Information Act; and also charged that the FBI and the CIA have been tacitly co-operating with international drug trafficing.

These are very serious charges. It seems to me that for the agencies named in these charges to break into a Church with axes at five o'clock in the morning, that this only serves to indicate that these very agencies have something very grave to hide.

I urge you, as the chief executive, not to be impressed by name calling and abuse of federal power, but to investigate to discover the truth, and to act upon that information.

**<u>PURPOSE</u>**: To advise of the initial assessment of compromise of national security information and material as a result of the penetration of Government agencies by the Founding Church of Scientology.

DETAILS: On 8/1/77, through the cooperation of the Criminal Investigative Division, the Document Classification Office received a number of documents deemed to be sensitive which were forwarded to FBIHQ by the Los Angeles Division. Initial review of these documents has determined a total of 20 documents classified "Secret" and 45 documents classified "Confidential" have, in all likelihood, been compromised through penetration efforts by the Church of Scientology. This preliminary review has determined that classified documents from eight Government agencies are involved, including the National Security Agency and the Central Intelligence Agency which are members of the intelligence community. Other material of a sensitive nature, although not classified, has also been compromised.

To date, we have not determined that any classified FBI material or Justice Department material has been compromised, although one copy each of nonclassified information originating in the Justice Department and in the FBI Chicago Office is involved. in the material forwarded by Los Angeles which has been reviewed by the Document Classification -9 Office. b? On 8/2/77, Department Security Office, and Enforcement Administration Security Office, were permitted access to the compromised documents, it being noted it has been determined that members of the Church of Scientology have penetrated the Civil Division of the Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration. 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

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preliminary review determined that in all likelihood most of the 65 classified documents compromised were those in the files of the Drug Enforcement Administration, including those disseminated to the Drug Enforcement Administration by other agencies.

The Document Classification Office (Security Office) is in the process of notifying the other agencies involved so they may review the compromised documents to make a damage assessment.

**RECOMMENDATION:** This matter is being coordinated with the Criminal Investigative Division by the Document Classification Office and you will be advised of all pertinent developments.
